Date: Friday, January 29, 2010

Dinner: A catered dinner will be provided for all judges, starting around 5:30PM. Held at the McGowan Café of the Carlisle High School. Come enjoy some fellowship before judging begins!

Times: Dinner at 5:30PM. Judging begins at 6PM and lasts until we are finished. Though typically finished by 10PM, the more judges we have, the quicker it goes.

Training: A brief training session will be held in the same Café as above. This helps everyone understand the process involved in judging projects. Judging is done in pairs or teams. After training, we walk (or drive) up to the Swartz building.

Directions/Parking: Directions to the High School can be found on the website: casac.us

Parking is in front of the McGowan building of the Carlisle High School. The Café is directly in front of the main entrance doors (main entrance is at the rear of the circular driveway). After dinner, cars may be moved up to the Swartz building for easier departure after judging.

Supplies: All supplies are provided by CASAC at the Fair. You do not need to bring anything with you.
